Currently Working At:

- 2 This is a description of the knowledge / skills / understanding that your child is working at in each subject; this ranges from Emerging to Excelling. + / - have been used to indicate the extent to which that description is being met.

Progress:

- 3 Progress comments have been chosen to reflect the learning that has been completed and expectations of where your child should be at this point in the year (depending on the route / pathway they have been placed on).

Behaviour / Attitude to Learning / Attitude to Home Learning:

- 4 Your child has been given a score (1, 2, or 3) for his/her behaviour, attitude to learning in lessons and attitude to home learning. The key (overleaf) provides an overview of what each score means.

Rise Points / Behaviour Points / Attendance:

- 5 RISE Points are the number of reward points your child has achieved since the start of the year. When students achieve a certain number of points they will be rewarded with a badge to wear on the blazer lapel. The key indicates the number of points needed for each colour badge. Behaviour Points are a total of points accrued for any instances of poor behaviour. You will also see your child's percentage attendance since the start of the year. The Attendance key describes how we would describe your child's attendance since the start of the academic year.

- Behaviour that is Expected, Unsatisfactory and a Cause for Concern;
